

FROM KUSA: (3) All exhibitors/handlers are personally responsible for the control of their dogs at all times and shall be personally liable for any claims which may be made in respect of injuries/damage which may arise or be caused by their dogs.

PRIZES: Floating Trophies for winners of Stakes.
Prizes, certificates and rosettes for placings.

ENTRY RULES: Payment or proof of payment must accompany entries.

No late entries will be accepted.

All persons attending the trials must consider themselves absolutely under the control of the officials. These trials will be conducted under the KUSA Constitution and Show Regulations Schedule 3, Schedule 1 and Field Trial Regulations Schedule 5(c) Retrievers. A copy of these regulations will be available at the venue.

In terms of section 5(c) regulations:

- 1.2.8.1 Bitches in season within the precincts of the trial are forbidden.
 - 1.2.8.2 Castrated dogs and spayed bitches are eligible for entry.
 - 1.2.8.3 Conditions attracting immediate disqualification are set out in regulation 31 Schedule 3 of the KUSA regulations for Championship shows subject to 1.2.8.1 and 1.2.8.2 above.
 - 1.2.8.4 Only dogs taking part in the Field Trials are allowed at the venue.
 - 1.2.8.5 The judge's decision is FINAL
- Anyone taking part in the Field Trials, who openly questions the decision of the Judge/s, shall render himself liable to be reported to the Field Trial Liaison Council of the KUSA.
- All Exhibitors/Handlers are personally responsible for the control of their dogs at all times and shall be personally liable for any claims which may be made in respect of injuries which may arise or be caused by their dogs

DEFINITIONS:

OPEN STAKE: Is for Retrievers without restriction as to age or previous performance. In order for an Open stake to carry champion status, the minimum number of dogs to actually take part in the trial shall be eight.

LIMITATION OF ENTRIES:

The trial is being conducted with artificially reared birds, so the number of entries will not be limited, save that no person shall handle more than three dogs in any one stake.

NATURE OF TRIAL: The trial shall simulate as closely as possible those conditions which can be expected in a natural shoot, and the dogs will be required to walk up and execute marked and unmarked retrieves and enter water. The conditions met shall not vary materially from one dog to another.

LIABILITY: The Committee shall exercise all reasonable care in conducting this trial, but it must be clearly understood that, due to the nature of the sport, competitors, spectators and officials are invited to enter at their own risk and in doing so absolve The Cape Field Trial Club, Committee and Landowners from any claim whatsoever arising from loss or damage by, or to any person or property during the course of the Trial.
