REGULATIONS FOR THE KUSA-IGP ANNUAL EVENT (MEISTERSCHAFT) SCHEDULE 05E (06) (Effective 01.04.2019)

1. LICENSING AND SHOW REGULATIONS

The Regulations relating to licensing and all other matters to do with Shows as set out in Schedule 3, Regulations for Championship Shows, Schedule 4 for Non-Championship Shows and Schedule 5B (2), Regulations for IGP of the Constitution of The Kennel Union of Southern Africa, shall apply to this competition so far as they can be relevant to the KUSA/IGP Annual Event and so far as they do not conflict with the specific terms of this Schedule 5E (6).

2. SCOPE OF THE LICENCE

A Club which is qualified to hold a Championship Show in the calendar year in which it is intended to hold the KUSA/IGP Annual event, may hold the event named in this Schedule in conjunction with such Championship Show or separate therefrom.

3. ELIGIBILITY OF DOGS FOR COMPETITION

Any dog may compete which is:-

3.1 of any breed which is registered in the Breed Registers of KUSA and whose eligibility is not in conflict with the Regulations herein described or has not been suspended or disqualified from competition by The Kennel Union of Southern Africa or any other FCI Recognised Canine Control Body.

4. HOST CLUBS.

At a meeting of the NIGPSC the host club for the next IGP Meisterschaft shall be decided.

5. QUALIFICATIONS FOR ENTRY

Meisterschaft: Dogs qualified in FCI-IGP 3 before the closing date for entries in the Meisterschaft. Dogs are not allowed to enter in a lower grade than what they have already been qualified in.

6. CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY

Each applicant for entering into this competition shall enclose with his entry form a photocopy of the Certificate or KUSA Workbook showing proof that his dog obtained the required qualifications during the year preceding the closing date for entries of the current Annual Event. The winner of the previous Meisterschaft will have automatic qualification into the event. No late entries will be accepted and entries must be posted on or prior to the closing date and will only be accepted within five (5) days of such date.

7. JUDGING

The judging will be undertaken by a senior IGP Judge, approved by The Kennel Union of Southern Africa and acceptable to the Club holding the licence for this event.

If, due to the number of dogs entered, any extra Judge or Judges are appointed then each Judge shall judge ALL the participants in one (1) or more sections (e.g. Group 1 - Tracking, Group II - Adaptability; Group III - Protection). Where more than one (1) Judge officiates the name of each Judge shall appear on any Certificate awarded. In the case of an equality of scores, the provisions of Schedule 5B (2) FCI-IGP, Regulation 3.5.3. The rule of maximum phases per judge as per UDC regulation shall apply.

8. PRIZES & TROPHIES

The KUSA Floating Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the event and subsidiary prizes to be first two (2) runners up.

9. SPONSORSHIP

The event may be sponsored permanently or on an annual basis by any organisation acceptable to both the Federal Council of The Kennel Union of South Africa and the current Host Club. In years when the event is sponsored, the title may be preceded by the name of the Sponsor. Should either Club or Sponsor wish to disassociate themselves with the event, this may not be done so as to prejudice the holding of the event in that year or any succeeding years. For this reason, a contract must be drawn up between the Club and any Sponsor establishing the rights and obligations of both, should either or both wish to withdraw from associating with this competition.
