# 8.2 Schedule 02 Reg. 4.10 – Dispensation for Registration of an Extraordinary Nature

# 8.2.1 Reclassification of oversize Toy Poodle as Miniature Poodle Ubhova Bentley ZA006621B24

Owner Dr Ellené Kleyn

Dr Kleyn applied to the KUSA office to have her Toy Poodle reclassified as a Miniature Poodle and submitted a Breed Evaluation Form signed by Mrs S Impey (see below).

The office responded to Dr Kleyn, explaining that there are no KUSA Regulations allowing reclassification of Poodles due to size. The three sizes of Poodle under the Poodle Breed Standard are recognised as separate varieties of the breed, each registered and exhibited as individual breeds. KUSA Regulations make no provision for changing the breed of a dog based on its size after initial registration. KUSA only allows reclassification of recessives such as coat types in Dachshunds.

Dr Kleyn was referred to

## KUSA Schedule 2 Regulation 4:

### Registration

Save and except for those dogs eligible for re-registration or registered or recorded in terms of Regulations 1.1.3 or 3, no dog may be registered unless:

4.1: Both its parents are registered in the same breed register and are of the same category. In cases where different categories of the same breeds exist, save and except for those breeds for which the Executive Committee has issued provisos permitting inter-variety matings and registration of the progeny from such matings, including re-classification, once only, of recessives, where necessary, on application from owners and the applicant for registration or reregistration submits an official Kennel Union form, with the certification of mating signed by both the owner of the Sire of such dog and any additional witness to the mating or an accredited agent, where prior arrangements have been made with the KUSA, and the owner of the Dam.

[Note: In South Africa, Poodles are bred and judged in accordance with The Royal Kennel Club Breed Standard, which recognises the sizes as three different breeds and there is no provision in KUSA Regulations for the reregistration of a Toy Poodle as a Miniature when it reaches adulthood. Moreover, the office is of the belief that if this reclassification is allowed, it would set an untenable precedent for several other breeds such as Miniature Dachshunds and Miniature Bull Terriers, which would also expect to be reclassified if oversized. Dr Kleyn has requested that this matter be referred to Exco for "final confirmation"]

## 8.4 Schedule 02 Reg.12 (12.1) – Adjudication for Registration

8.4.1 12.1 Notwithstanding anything in these Regulations contained, the Executive Committee may, in addition to the provisions of Schedule 1, Disciplinary Rules, Rule 11.1, for good reason, decline to register or record any dog or its transfer and may cancel any registration or recording and may alter any record of registration to reflect the correct status of affairs.

Explanation of a possible Disciplinary Case to be provided by the KUSA Secretary.

Authorisation sought from Exco to provisionally "suspend" all dogs, and any offspring they may have produced, implicated in the five (5) litters alleged to have been registered with incorrect parentage. Authorisation sought from Exco for the KUSA Secretary (who may ultimately be the Complainant in a Disciplinary Case) to launch and spearhead a full-scale investigation into the alleged erroneous registrations and, if required, to demand DNA Profiling of the dogs involved in the respective litters and the DNA Parentage Verification of all offspring, with a view to restoring the veracity of the KUSA Primary Breed Register for French Bulldogs. For the time being, to impose mandatory DNA Profiling and DNA Parentage Verification on all litter applications from non-implicated dogs until all KUSArequirements have been met by the breeder and the Register has been amended in accordance with DNA results. ## 9. **SCHEDULE 03 MATTERS**

## 9.1. Temporary Exclusion Orders (Schedule 03 Reg. 14 & Reg. 19.8)

9.1.1 **Temporary Exclusion Order** – American Akita – King's Throne J-Diamond – Reg No. ZA001150C23

It was reported that the abovementioned dog had acted and behaved aggressively by attacking the Judge at the Northern Free State Kennel Club Championship Show held on 31.08.2024. The Club has submitted the Incident Report Form (Annex A) and a statement from the injured party. Preliminary TEO issued 17.09.2024. See attached.

#### TEO confirmed.

The Owner has submitted a letter from behaviourist Christa Henning (see attached). The Owner has requested assistance from the KUSA Office regarding the required Canine Good Citizen test, given that he is based in Bloemfontein. The KUSA Office has been in touch with the FS&NC Provincial Council, as well as the Owner, to see what assistance could be provided.

# 9.2 Referral of TEO dogs to Fedco for Permanent Barring

Extract from the TEO Manual:

14.5 The Owner of any Implicated Dog, which has been issued with a confirmed TEO, has a maximum period of 12 (twelve) months from the date of the TEO (the date the TEO was confirmed by the Executive Committee) to successfully complete the requirements as provided for in Step 1, 2 and 3 of this Manual, failing which, the Executive Committee will

apply to the Federal Council to have the Implicated Dog permanently barred from entry to and exhibition at any future KUSA-licensed Shows/Events subject to compliance with the procedure as provided for in Clause 11.11 hereof.

11.11 The Owner of the Implicated dog must be informed by the Secretary of KUSA that the matter has been forwarded to the Federal Council and that he/she has the right to make written representations to the Federal Council as to why the Implicated dog should not be permanently barred from entering and exhibition at KUSA Shows/Events.

Report submitted to Fedco – awaiting feedback.

With permission from Exco, the list of dogs to be submitted to the Agenda of Fedco 06-2025. CPA to draft a letter to send to owners informing them of their right to appeal the decision, should they wish to do so.

On 03.04.2025, all Owners of dogs with TEOs over the 12-month limit were informed that their dogs would be tabled to Fedco 06-2025 for permanent disbarring. Several responses have been received, advising the present status of the dogs. To date no appeals have been received.

# 9.4 Entry in Contravention of Schedule 03 Regulations

18. WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITION

18.1 Once a dog has entered the ring to be exhibited in one of the Classes for which he had been entered in advance of the Show, the dog shall be exhibited in all subsequent Classes entered and in all the Challenges and Competitions as contemplated by Regulations 21, 22 and 24 for which it has qualified at that Show. Failure to enter the ring when required to compete in subsequent Classes or Challenges and Competitions as described above shall, at the discretion of the Executive Committee, render the dog liable for disqualification and the cancellation of any awards gained, irrespective of any objection having been lodged in terms of Regulation 31.

18.2 Withdrawal from competition at the Show is only permissible

18.2.1 when the Judge listed in the Schedule is changed; or

18.2.2 when a dog's Owner or its Authorised Agent deems it necessary due to the dog's illness, injury or other legitimate reason, and in either of the above eventualities, the dog shall be marked as ABSENT on the Judge's and Ring Steward's Sheets.

18.3 Once a dog has entered the ring with the intention to be exhibited, it shall for purposes of these Regulations be deemed as having been exhibited and may not leave the ring before completion of the judging of that Class unless

18.3.1 the dog is excused or dismissed by the Judge for any reason whatsoever; or

18.3.2 the dog is withdrawn by the handler due to illness, injury, lameness, bad behaviour, or for any reason considered sufficient not to continue competing

18.4 When a dog is excused or dismissed by the Judge, the Judge's and Ring Steward's Sheets shall be marked accordingly, e.g. DISMISSED/EXCUSED – LAMENESS,

DISMISSED/EXCUSED - AGGRESSION, etc.

18.5 When a dog is withdrawn by the handler for any reason, the handler must inform the Ring Steward, after which the dog shall be marked as WITHDRAWN on the Judge's and Ring Steward's Sheets.

18.6 If a dog's withdrawal from further competition is forced by an emergency, domestic or otherwise, formal permission shall be granted at the sole discretion of the Show Manager, once he is satisfied that sufficient cause has been shown why the dog should be withdrawn from further competition, after which the dog shall be marked as WITHDRAWN on the Judges' and Ring Steward's Sheets for the Class, Challenge or Competition from which the dog has been withdrawn.

18.7 For the avoidance of doubt, once a dog has, for whatever reason, been withdrawn, excused or dismissed from any one Class, Challenge or Competition, it shall not be permitted to compete in any further Classes, Challenges or Competitions at that Show.

4.2 Notes for the execution of the REGULATIONS FOR THE INTERNATIONAL WORKING DOG TRIALS AND INTERNATIONAL TRACKING DOG TRIALS OF THE FCI.

4.2.1 The minimum number of participants is four handlers.

Schedule 05B(02) Appendix B

#### **Trial Participants**

The trial participant must meet the entry deadline for the event. The participant also agrees to pay the entry fee upon submission of the entry form. If the participant cannot participate for whatever reason, he/she must advise the Trial Secretary (PL) immediately. The participant is required to provide the vaccination certificate and uphold the animal rights guidelines. The participant must adhere to the instructions of the judge (LR) as well as the Trial Secretary. The handler must present his/her dog in a sportsmanlike manner regardless of the results in any given phase, he is obliged to continue for the remaining phases of the event. The trial ends with the results (awards ceremony) and the return of the scorebook.

The examination (trial) must have "minimum of 4 participants per trial day. The minimum number of participants per day may only be less if for FCI-BH/VT or BH/VT (NPO) examinations these dogs pass and try for a further examination (FCI-IGP-1, FCI-IFH 1) at the same event. A dog handler may only take part in an examination with the same dog. (A two-day test is considered as an examination event.) A dog handler may enter a maximum of two dogs for an examination at an event. A dog may only acquire one title within a event. Exception: FCI-BH/VT or BH/VT (NPO) in conjunction with another level 1 (FCI-IGP) title.

Prerequisite for entering a trial is that owner and dog handler belong to a club of the national organization which is recognized by the FCI. Exceptions to this can be determined by the national canine organization (FCI-NCO) only for FCI-BH/VT or BH/VT (NPO) examinations. Following the incidents listed in the minutes of Exco 02-2025 and Exco 03-2025, where Clubs failed to comply with the Regulations pertaining to the number of handlers on a day for FCI-IGP Trials, and at the Executive Committee's request, the IGP Fedco Portfolio-holder was approached to attempt to broker some form of resolution.

Recommendations have been made as per the attached response received from Federal Councillor, Ms Nikki Redtenbacher.

The members of Exco recorded their thanks to Ms Redtenbacher for attending to the matter and providing Exco with her recommendations. NS sent a letter to Mr Swartz, copied to the members of the NIGPSC, conveying Ms Redtenbacher's recommendations and urging that the recommendations be actioned to, hopefully, resolve the ongoing non-compliance problem at IGP Trials.
