# 7.1 **Disciplinary Sub-Committee** 7.1.1 Case 2024-03 - KUSA vs Ingram The Respondent has lodged an Appeal against the Finding and the Penalties imposed by the DSC. The Notice of Appeal was received in time. The Appeal documentation is currently under consideration by the Sub-Committee of Inquiry (SCI). Noted. The Appellant has notified the SCI of his intention to appear in person at the FAC Hearing and has paid the Appeal Appearance Fee. Awaiting the appointment of the FAC and the date and venue for the FAC Hearing. Noted. The date mooted by the FAC for the Appellant to appear in person in front of the in-personassembled FAC (17 July 2025) has been turned down by the Appellant, since he would be travelling on that date. The Appellant, through his attorney, has been requested to provide a few "window periods" during which he would be available to appear in front of the FAC, to assist the FAC with setting a date for the Appeal hearing. The Appellant also requested that the Appeal hearing be conducted in Cape Town, which request has been forwarded to the Chairman of the FAC. The venue of the Appeal hearing is at the discretion of the Chairman of FAC, in consultation with the members of the FAC, and the Appellant has been informed that, if so decided by the FAC, he should be prepared to travel to Johannesburg. In terms of Schedule 01 Rule 12.8, the Appellant also has the option of joining the meeting of the in-person-assembled FAC virtually (only permissible for FAC hearings), and he has been requested to also consider this option should he wish to avoid travel to Johannesburg. At the time of compiling this Exco Agenda, no response had been received from the Appellant's attornev. Two dates in August 2025 have been proposed to the Appellant's attorney for the Appeal to be heard by the FAC and a response was awaited. Noted. 7.1.2 Case 2024-04 - KUSA vs Botes The Respondent has lodged an Appeal against of the Finding and the Penalties imposed by the DSC. The Notice of Appeal was received in time. The Appeal documentation is currently under consideration by the Sub-Committee of Inquiry (SCI). Noted. The Appellant had been granted an extension by the SCI to restructure his Appeal to meet the requirements set out in Schedule 01. The revised documentation has since been received and. since the Appeal included new evidence, it is incumbent on the Respondent (the KUSA Secretary) to serve an Answering Affidavit on the Appellant. The preparation of the Respondent's affidavit is in process. The case has been referred to the Chairman of the Fedco Appeals Committee (FAC). requesting the appointment of an FAC to hear the Appeal. Noted. The Appeal has been set down for hearing on 17.07.2025. 7.1.3 Case 2024-05 - KUSA (Austen & NFSKC) vs Pieterse, Van den Doel & Katts A DSC has been appointed, and a face-to-face hearing has been scheduled for 16.05.2025 in Johannesburg. The Minutes and the Record of Proceedings of the DSC hearing on 16 & 20 May 2025 reflect the following:

Case 2024-05 – KUSA (Austen & NFSKC) vs Pieterse, Van den Doel & Katts

The above Case was heard by the Disciplinary Sub-Committee (DSC) on 16 May 2025 and the Minutes and Record of Proceedings of the hearing were released on 17 June 2025.

## Finding:

After careful consideration of all the submitted evidence, documents, still images, video clip and affidavits, the DSC unanimously reached the following decision, on a balance of probabilities, with regard to Case 2024-05 before them **that the complaint against the Respondents was fully substantiated by the presented evidence** in that the Respondents had acted in a manner that was improper, disorderly, disrespectful, and damaging to the reputation of KUSA.

#### Penalties:

Taking into consideration the nature of the misconduct, and the fact that they were first offenders, the DSC imposed the following penalty on each of the three (3) Respondents:

In terms of Rule 11.1.7 of Schedule 09, the Respondents are each hereby reprimanded and warned regarding the above contravention of Schedule 03 and 09 as outlined in this document.

The Respondents have been notified of their right to appeal as per Schedule 01 Rule 12 withing a period of fifteen (15) working days, due to expire on 8 July 2025.

The Minutes and the Record of Proceedings were noted and confirmed.

No Notice of Appeal has been received from the Respondents within the permitted period for Appeal.

The Breeder transferred the dog into another member's name and the dog has subsequently been transferred twice, but never that of the person indicated on the CC. In addition to the CCs required for the Champion application, six (6) BOB certificates and one CACIB was also provided all showing the incorrect Registered Owner. Exco decision required. A R500 fine to be imposed on the Registered Owner for the submission of an Official Show Entry Form in contravention of the Regulations. 9.5 Best Puppy of Breed incorrectly awarded 22.2 Once the Best of Breed has been awarded, the remaining exhibits compete against the runner-up to the Best of Breed exhibit (i.e. the relevant Reserve Challenge Certificate winner or

the runner-up in the relevant Champions Class) for Reserve Best of Breed. The Reserve Best of Breed shall be awarded to the dog placed second to the Best of Breed, which shall progress no further. For the avoidance of doubt, should the Best of Breed be awarded to the Challenge Certificate winner that is also the winner of the Champions Class, the Reserve Challenge Certificate winner as well as the runner-up in the Champions Class shall be entitled to challenge for the Reserve Best of Breed. 22.3 In the event of the Best of Breed or Reserve Best of Breed winners being entered in the Minor Puppy or Puppy classes, that exhibit shall automatically be awarded Best Puppy of 9.5.1 Best Puppy in Breed in the Highway Kennel Club 2 Champion Show held on Saturday 05.07.2025 at the Durban Shogweni Club. The Judge awarded Kingkusch James Dean (ZA010226B24) Reserve Best of Breed, but didn't award him Best Puppy in Breed. BPIB was awarded to the minor puppy bitch Kingkusch Glitter N Gold (ZA010338B24). The Best of Breed was awarded to the Best Junior in Breed, Kinakusch Unexpected Blessings (ZA006338B24). His breeder contacted Micheal Vorster, Secretary of Highway Kennel Club, to raise this complaint and he advised that a complaint is to be lodged with the Secretary of KUSA, since it wasn't raised on the day. As per Schedule 3 Regulation 22.2 and 22.3 Best Puppy in Breed was incorrectly awarded to the minor bitch Kingkusch Glitter N Gold (ZA010338B24). Exco decision required. ### DO&JCD: Master/Deceased Estates/How to report

The following documentation is required by KUSA in order to proceed with any application (new or pending) submitted by or on behalf of a deceased member:

- 1. Certified copy of Death Certificate
- 2. Letter of Executorship or Letter of Authority issued by the Master of the High Court in terms of the Administration of Estates Act 66 of 1965.
- 3. A Certified copy of the Will confirming heirs and the bequeathment of an Affix (Kennel Name).

The following are the prevailing principles pertaining to Deceased Estates, as per by the KUSA Legal Adviser, within the context in respect of the KUSA Constitution and its Regulations:

- 1. The KUSA Constitution does not make provision for juristic entities such as Deceased Estates only for Members and Affiliated Clubs.
- 2. Membership of a deceased member cannot be renewed the person is deceased, and no one can act in their stead. Membership ends when the person dies.
- 3. A KUSA Affix/Kennel Name, registered in the **sole ownership** of a deceased, "dies with the deceased" and may not be renewed or be transferred into another person's registered ownership, unless specified in the deceased's Will. The Kennel Name may not be used as a Prefix or Suffix for any dogs bred **after the death** of the Affix-holder, but may be used in the case of litters bred prior to the member death with the requisite authorisation of the Executor.
- 4. The appointed Executor of the Estate is tasked with the distribution of the deceased's assets in accordance with the Will, the settling of debts and the winding up of administrative matters, etc., but is not empowered to act in the stead of the deceased. An Executor cannot bequeath anything. The duty and mandate of an Executor is for a finite period, i.e. until the Estate is finalised and all assets distributed. Thereafter, they cannot continue with the deceased's affairs or business unless the Master of the Court has issued a decree giving authority for the Executor to continue.
- 5. Thus, an Executor can only distribute assets i.e. arrange for the transfer of dogs into the registered ownership of a living person, whom thereafter can breed and register litters with said dog on the proviso that KUSA Regulations are met, in respect of KUSA Membership, etc.
- 6. The Executor may only sign Applications on behalf of the deceased member if the application pertains to something that happened prior to the member's death, whilst still living, i.e. Application for registration of dogs and litters.
- 7. The Executor does not have the power or right to sanction or sign off or continue the breeding of the dogs in the deceased's registered ownership, save and except if the continuation of breeding by the Executor is recorded in the last Will of the deceased. The Executor would need to be named in person in the Will. Otherwise, the Executor can only arrange and sign off the transfer of the dogs into the registered ownership of a natural person.
- 8. The Executor is not authorised or empowered to sign Official Show Entry Forms for dogs registered in the deceased's name and the dogs may not be entered into any Championship Shows in the name of a Deceased Estate, save and except for Breed Specialist and Multi-breed Specialist Shows, where KUSA membership is not a prerequisite for entry, as a Deceased Estate has no recognition or standing in the KUSA Constitution. The dogs can only be entered in Shows if in the registered ownership of a current KUSA Member that is a natural person. Juristic entities such as "Deceased Estates" are not considered as a KUSA Member. Dogs entered in the registered ownership of a deceased member is viewed as having been entered *ultra*

	vires the KUSA Regulations and Exco has the authority to withdraw any awards won if brought to its attention.
