2.	MINUTES
	The Chairman opened the meeting and thanked the members of the Executive Committee and others for their attendance at short notice.
	Penalties imposed by the Disciplinary Sub-Committee (DSC) at its Hearing of Case 2025-01 – Olivier vs Fyfe – on Tuesday, 28 October 2025
	Having circulated documents to the Executive Committee and others in advance of the meeting, the Chairman explained the urgency of the matter, i.e. the relief sought by Mr DH Fyfe to show certain dogs in his registered ownership at the Cape Top Dog Invitational on Saturday, 29 November 2025. The Penalties imposed by the DSC at its Hearing of Case 2025-01 – Olivier vs Fyfe – constrained these dogs (5 in total) from competing at KUSA-licensed events.
	In view of the fact that the imposition of Penalties, as enumerated Schedule 01 Rule 11, were confined to Respondents, the Chairman thought it prudent to convene this Extraordinary Meeting of the Executive Committee to consider whether <i>Point 3</i> , under the heading <i>Penalties</i> , in the <i>Minutes and Record of Proceedings</i> of the Hearing held on 28 October 2025 should be reviewed by the DSC, as provided for in Schedule 01 Rules 10.16 and 10.17. Since Mr Fyfe was <i>not</i> the Respondent in the case, he was not in a position to appeal against the Finding and Penalties under Schedule 01 Rule 12.
	After deliberation, the members of the Executive Committee decided , unanimously , to request the DSC to review the Penalty in question and, if removed, to amend the <i>Minutes</i> and <i>Record of Proceedings</i> to reflect the change and any consequential changes.
