7.1.2 **Case 2025-01 – Olivier vs Fyfe**

The Letter of Complaint and the Complainant's papers have been served on the Respondent by the KUSA Secretary. Noted.

From the Minutes and Record of Proceedings of the DSC Hearing conducted on MS Teams on Thursday, 28 October 2025:

Finding:

The DSC thoroughly perused the documentation before them to determine whether the Respondent had indeed infringed the two main points of the complaint. In particular, they noted the various photographs of the dog in question, and the comments made by the Complainant, the Respondent, the breeder of the dog and other members of dogdom and broader society. These were weighed and assessed, on a balance of probabilities, to determine whether or not the Respondent had indeed infringed the Rules and Regulations she allegedly breached.

The DSC further noted that cyber-bullying was becoming more prevalent within dogdom and had the potential to discredit the sport and damage the credibility of those involved in dog-showing, whether they were competing as exhibitors, officiating as Judges, or acting in the capacity of Show Officials. This, in turn, tarnishes the image of KUSA and its licensed activities, purebred dogs, and KUSA membership in the eyes of the general public.

It had been brought to the attention of the DSC that an application for KUSA membership had been received from the Respondent's husband on 16 June 2025, which was duly processed on 18 June 2025. On 20 June 2025, the KUSA Office received and processed an application from the Respondent to transfer five (5) of her dogs into her husband's

name after disciplinary action had been instituted against her by the Complainant. Such action by the Respondent could only be assumed to have been a pre-emptive step to avoid any penalties stemming from Case 2025-01. The dogs transferred were:

- Allmark Sugarbird of Talliya (Reg No. ZA008492B24)
- Talliya Marilyn Monroe (Reg No. ZA005303B23)
- Talliya Tourmaline Titan (Reg No. ZA002228B22)
- Ch Talliya Sergeant Pepper (Reg No. ZA001342B21)
- Ch Liashasue Winds of Change of Talliya (Reg No. ZA002166B18)

Taking the Respondent's alleged transgressions of KUSA Regulations and Codes into account, compounded by the pre-emptive transfers of dogs, ostensibly to avoid the imposition of sanctions against them in an anticipated guilty finding, and in consideration of the papers, screenshots and other evidence entered into the record of this Case 2025-01, the DSC found, unanimously, and on a balance of probabilities, **that the complaint had been fully substantiated by the Complainant**.

Penalties:

- In terms of Schedule 01 Rule 11.1.2, the Respondent is excluded from taking part in, or having any connection with, or attending or participating or handling a dog at a Show, Obedience Class, Working Trial or Field Trial or any other event held under KUSA licence, or from acting as an officer of a Club for a period of thirty-two (32) weeks.
- In terms of Schedule 01 Rule 11.1.3, the Respondent is disqualified from registration, recording, transfer, exhibition or competition or evaluation of a dog owned by him or her or registered or recorded in his or her name, or jointly with another or others, or in the name of a nominee, **for a period of thirty-two (32) weeks**.
- 3. The DSC further ruled that, since the Respondent transferred her dogs into the name of her husband in what could only have been an attempt to avoid penalties arising from this hearing, that the five (5) dogs mentioned above, which were in the Respondent's registered ownership at the time of the transgression, form part of the Penalties imposed on the Respondent in 1 & 2 above.
- 4. The DSC ruled that the Penalties as described above would run concurrently and these Penalties shall take effect on Thursday, 20 November 2025 and terminate on Wednesday, 1 July 2026.

The Respondent has been notified of her right of appeal as per Schedule 01 Rule 12.

The Veteran bitch was then placed second in the Group. The owner reported the error after the show. Email attached. Decision required. Awards to be withdrawn. 10.5.3 Margate Kennel Club - 27.09.2025 Schedule 03: 5.17 Where a Club, for any reason whatsoever, has been unable to finalise its Draft Schedule twelve (12) weeks before the first day of the Show, no licence shall be issued for that event. If a licence has already been paid for, Licence Fees will be refunded to the Club, subject to the deduction of Penalty Fees incurred up to twelve (12) weeks and, should the Penalty Fees be in excess of the Licence Fees, the Club shall be responsible for payment of the shortfall. The above Club applied for their September Championship Show licence on 27.03.2025. The Office proceeded to process the application while waiting for further documents, and requested Clearance from the Clubs Department on 30.04.2025 before issuing the licence. The Club was not cleared due to outstanding AGM documents (Financials). The Club was informed on 27.06.2025 that they were still not in good standing and could not be granted a licence. No licence was issued, however, the Club went ahead with the Show. The Office was alerted to that fact, when Show Returns were received on 09.10.2025. Carried forward to the next Agenda. Club statement attached. Decision required. Unlicensed Show and therefore not a valid event. All awards to be withdrawn. MH agreed to ensure that Record Cards of all dogs that had received awards are amended. For this purpose, NS undertook to provide MH with a list of awards made at the unlicensed Show. 10.5.4 Entry in Contravention of Schedule 03 Regulations - Absentees **TKC Kennel Club –** 12.10.2025 18. WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITION 18.1 Once a dog has entered the ring to be exhibited in one of the Classes for which he had been entered in advance of the Show, the dog shall be exhibited in all subsequent Classes entered and in all the Challenges and Competitions as contemplated by Regulations 21, 22 and 24 for which it has qualified at that Show. Failure to enter the ring when required to compete in subsequent Classes or Challenges and Competitions as described above shall, at the discretion of the Executive Committee, render the dog liable for disqualification and the cancellation of any awards gained, irrespective of any objection having been lodged in terms of Regulation 31.

18.2 Withdrawal from competition at the Show is only permissible

18.2.1 when the Judge listed in the Schedule is changed; or

18.2.2 when a dog's Owner or its Authorised Agent deems it necessary due to the dog's illness, injury or other legitimate reason, and in either of the above eventualities, the dog shall be marked as ABSENT on the Judge's and Ring Steward's Sheets.

18.3 Once a dog has entered the ring with the intention to be exhibited, it shall for purposes of these Regulations be deemed as having been exhibited and may not leave the ring before completion of the judging of that Class unless

18.3.1 the dog is excused or dismissed by the Judge for any reason whatsoever; or

18.3.2 the dog is withdrawn by the handler due to illness, injury, lameness, bad behaviour, or for any reason considered sufficient not to continue competing

18.4 When a dog is excused or dismissed by the Judge, the Judge's and Ring Steward's Sheets shall be marked accordingly, e.g. DISMISSED/EXCUSED – LAMENESS, DISMISSED/EXCUSED – AGGRESSION, etc.

18.5 When a dog is withdrawn by the handler for any reason, the handler must inform the Ring Steward, after which the dog shall be marked as WITHDRAWN on the Judge's and Ring Steward's Sheets.

18.6 If a dog's withdrawal from further competition is forced by an emergency, domestic or otherwise, formal permission shall be granted at the sole discretion of the Show Manager, once he is satisfied that sufficient cause has been shown why the dog should be withdrawn from further competition, after which the dog shall be marked as WITHDRAWN on the Judges' and Ring Steward's Sheets for the Class, Challenge or Competition from which the dog has been withdrawn.

18.7 For the avoidance of doubt, once a dog has, for whatever reason, been withdrawn, excused or dismissed from any one Class, Challenge or Competition, it shall not be permitted to compete in any further Classes, Challenges or Competitions at that Show. The following dogs failed to appear after being exhibited and promoted to the next level:

05E(29) – Regulations for the KUSA South African Agility Championships – to officiate as one of the Judges for the South African Agility Championships 2026

Submitted by the National Agility Sub-Committee (NAgSC).

Circumstances: The call for judge applications was open for the required period, during which only two applications were received — from Mr Wayne Arneil and Ms Tam White. Upon reviewing the documentation submitted by Ms White, we identified two areas where she does not yet fully meet the standard judging criteria, as detailed below:

• Duration as an Official Judge:

Ms White completed her schedule 03 exam on the 13.08.2022, but only completed her qualifying judging rounds in April 2023 – this is due to Ms White residing in Cape Town and as is very well known, Cape Town has a **very** limited number of shows and thus opportunity for her to complete the assessments in any faster time. As such, she will only meet the requirements of Schedule 05L Appendix E Regulation 4.2.1 namely, "Only KUSA Championship Show Agility Judges with a minimum of three (3) years' experience in judging Agility will be considered", in April 2026, shortly before the Championships take place.

Number of Judging Appointments:

The requirement stipulates a minimum of six (6) Contact and six (6) Non-Contact judging appointments within the three-year period. To date, Ms White has completed four (4) Contact and five (5) Non-Contact appointments. In light of these factors, we respectfully submit the following supporting considerations for your evaluation:

• Re-opening of the Application Period:

Upon identifying that Ms White did not currently fulfil all requirements, the AWC Working Group re-opened the application period for an additional one and a half weeks (until 19.10.2025) and circulated the opportunity again to all provincial judging groups. Unfortunately, no further applications were received during this extended period.

• Qualification Timeline:

Although Ms White is not currently eligible under the three-year rule, she will be fully qualified by the time of the KUSA SA Agility Championships 2026 (scheduled for May/June 2026).

Upcoming Judging Appointments:

Ms White has several confirmed judging commitments, which will ensure she meets and exceeds the required number of appointments by the time of the event, as follows:

25 October 2025 – NAL 2 & 3 (Cape Town): 2 Contact & 2 Non-Contact rounds 2 November 2025 – Championship Show (KUSA Classic)

2 November 2020 - Original Original Machiner (NOOA Classic)

22 November 2025 - NAL 4: 1 Contact & 1 Non-Contact round

7 March 2026 - Championship Show

All SAC Rounds: 4 Contact & 4 Non-Contact rounds

These scheduled appointments will ensure she has the necessary experience and practical exposure well in advance of the KUSA SA Championships.

Taking all of the above into account, we respectfully request Exco to grant dispensation for Ms White to serve as a Judge for the 2026 KUSA SA Agility Championships, and that Mr Arneil, who is fully qualified, be appointed as the National Coordinator for the same. Mr Arneil will, of course, oversee and support Ms White through the process as required. We trust that the above demonstrates our position and due diligence.
